JOB DESCRIPTION



ROLE: FUNDRAISING LEAD

Reports to: Director of Communications & Engagement

Direct reports: None initially

Contract details: Full time, 35 hours per week, permanent

Salary £40,000 per annum

ROLE SUMMARY

To devise and implement fundraising initiatives and strategies, build and manage partnerships, working creatively to grow existing funding and creating a pipeline of opportunities that focusses on growth and long-term support. Coin Street currently raises £100k annually from trusts and foundations but, with this new role we are looking for you to take us to the next level, initially increasing our annual revenue income target to £200k, working across a range of grant applications from £20k-£100k. You will also support our current campaign to raise capital funds for the transformation of Bernie Spain Gardens north park. Over time we see the potential to grow fundraised income significantly.

TEAM OVERVIEW

This is a new role within the Communications team of eight team members. Although you will work closely with senior leaders who are highly experienced in fundraising, this will be a new function in Coin Street, so you will be responsible for setting up new processes and systems.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- 1. Work with the Director of Communications and Engagement and Leadership team to develop a robust strategy that identifies funding opportunities from trusts, foundations, public and private sources. You will have significant autonomy to craft and develop your pipeline with a personal revenue income target of circa £200k in the first year.
- 2. Work collaboratively with the Leadership team members and our community team to ensure excellent stewardship, cultivating new prospects and furthering existing relationships whilst ensuring good practice.
- 3. Develop a detailed knowledge of Coin Street, its history and future ambitions in order to produce a case for support, which will enable you to create engaging funding applications and communications.
- 4. Research, identify and apply to trusts and foundations and other prospective funders, and manage key relationships to grow these to become more sustainable partnerships.

- 5. Increase fundraising capacity for future years by developing and maintaining robust processes around budgeting, forecasting and planning, and reporting on the effective use of funds working closely with the finance, community and communications teams.
- 6. Report to funders on the impact of their donations, working closely with community team members and communications to collate data and case studies.
- 7. Provide regular information and stewardship of relationships with funders including site or project visits, meeting with operational and senior staff, special events and ad hoc meetings.
- 8. To lead, manage, develop and motivate team members. Agree delivery targets and KPIs and ensure that they are achieved and, where possible, exceeded. Create opportunities for personal development for engagement in cross-team projects.
- 9. Develop and maintain relationships between funders and colleagues across the organisation and at all levels.
- 10. Undertake any other reasonable duties, as may be required from time to time, as consistent with the scope of this role.

- 1. Proven experience of working as a fundraiser, with demonstrable experience of working with charitable trusts and/or grant makers. This role will suit a strong experienced fundraiser looking to step up and work more autonomously.
- 2. A track record of writing and submitting successful proposals and achieving fundraising targets
- 3. Proven success at implementing fundraising processes and systems, ideally having built these from scratch, with a willingness to build capacity within the team over time.
- 4. Understanding of the importance of effective stakeholder management to the success of the organisation
- 5. Experience in managing fundraising income budgets, forecasting and planning.

- 7. Excellent writing skills with ability to craft compelling cases for support and to communicate these effectively through written and verbal channels, bringing a creative flair to their role with a talent for expressing complex ideas in simple and effective language

- 10. Ability to manage a varied workload and work under pressure, prioritising tasks as appropriate to meet deadlines
- 11. Self-motivated with the ability to work autonomously and on own initiative
- 12. Flexible approach and commitment to achieving results and motivated by working to targets. Willing to work on proposals across the range of income levels.
